RE: Chach CC, Disciplinary Matter – Executive Committee decision of 31st July 2008.

I wish to thank you for providing a detailed verbally report. The committee discussed the matter and reached a decision.

The Committee considered the following items:

- Umpires report – Mohammed Nazir.
- Verbal statements from Naeem Khan, Captain of Chach
- Verbal statement on behalf of Ikram UI Haq
- Ikram U Haq was given the opportunity to attend but choose not to do so.

From the above information the committee has come to the following decision(s): -

- To apply a ban on Mr Ikram U Haq from taking part in all cricket for a duration of 6 weeks with the ban commencing from 9th August 2008 – 19th September 2008 for showing threatening behaviour to an umpire (Level 4) and using language that seriously offended and humiliated an umpire (Level 4).
- To apply a ban on Mr Naeem Khan (Captain) from taking part in all cricket for a duration of 2 weeks with the ban commencing from 9th August 2008 – 22nd August 2008 for not setting an example prior to the incident by running onto the pitch during the match and for not controlling the player in question – verbal abuse.

The club involved has the right of appeal and can do so by sending in letter of appeal which clearly indicates the ground(s) of appeal. Please also attach a fee of £50.00 made payable to Quaid e Azam SCL. The appeal must be received within seven days of receiving the original decision.
